Higher Ground

Higher Ground Dromore, a dynamic community group, received plants, seeds, and tools to enhance local spaces, benefiting 4,000 people. With 70 volunteers contributing 1,500 hours, they collaborated with the local school Dromore High Eco Club to plant and nurture greenery. The project encouraged civic pride, sustainable gardening, and community involvement. Volunteers upcycled materials, like transforming an old bath into a wormery. The initiative sparked positive local engagement, with other groups inspired to take action. Dromore's efforts have earned them multiple accolades, including the 2025 LHLH Community Award and Eco School of the Year.
